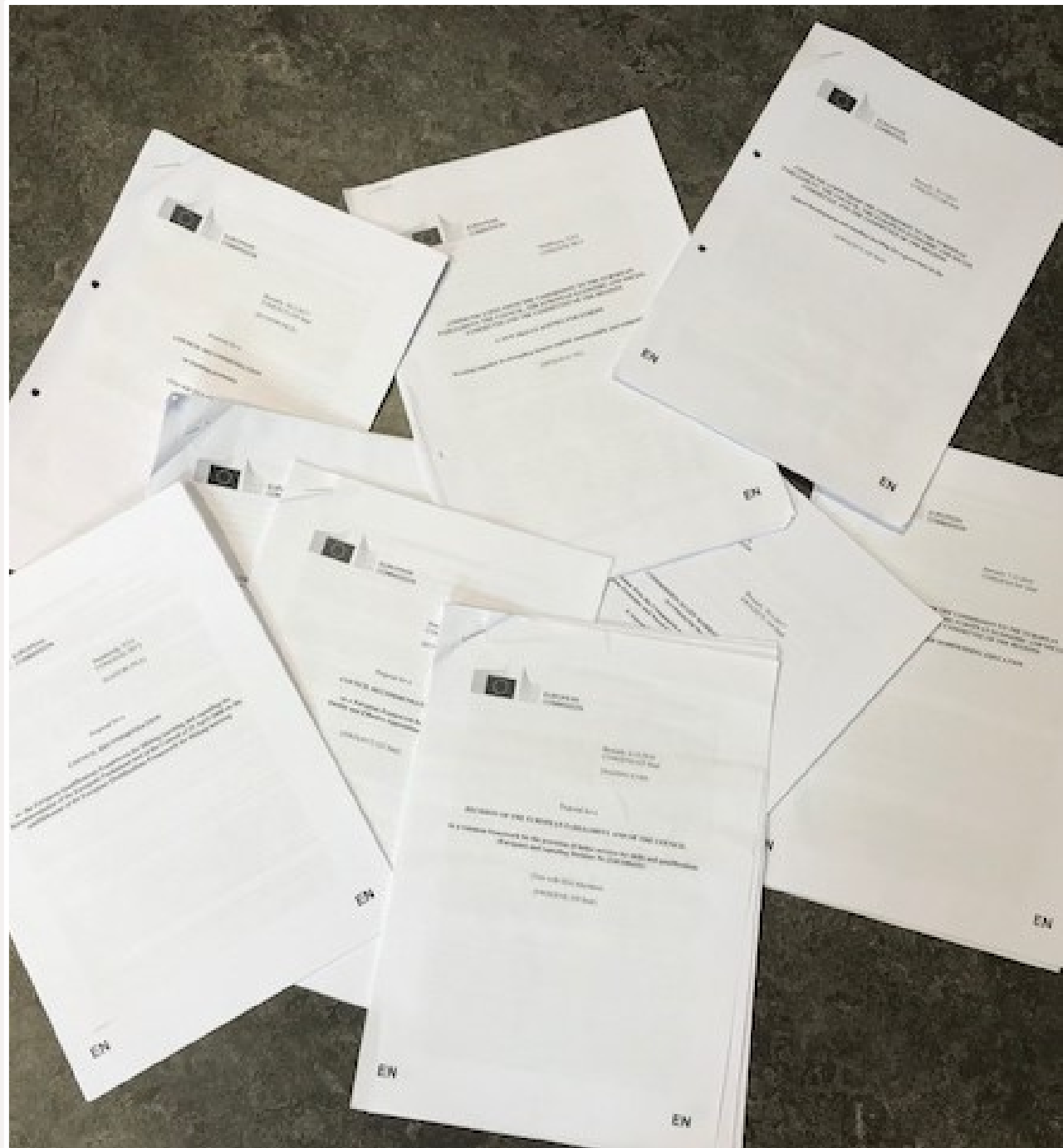
Education and training 2020

- I 2009 ble medlemsstatene og Europakommisjonen enige om å fokusere samarbeidet fram til 2020 på:
 - Å styrke **livslang læring og mobilitet**
 - Å øke **kvalitet og effektivitet i utdanning og opplæring**
 - Å fremme **rettferdighet, sosial samhörighet og aktivt medborgerskap**
 - Å stimulere **kreativitet og innovasjon**
- Dette samarbeidet er kjent som *Education and training 2020*.
