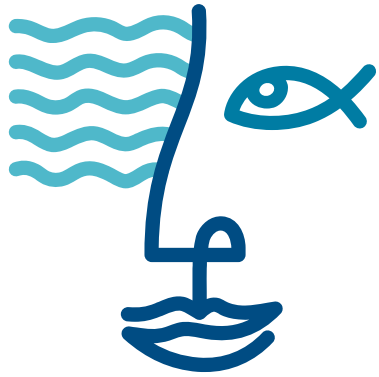


Food for thought:
