Norway holds the presidency of the Nordic Council of Ministers in 2022. The Norwegian Programme for the for the presidency of the Nordic Council of Ministers 2022 will work on the UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development and the UN Decade of Action on Nutrition, as well as on promoting food from the sea and sustainable food systems, all of which follow up directly on the sustainable development goals and the Nordic vision. Norway is also leader of a Global Action Network under the United Nations Decade of Action on Nutrition (2016-2025), gaining and sharing knowledge globally to mobilize actions on sustainable aquatic foods for food security and nutrition. As part of the programme of the Norwegian presidency, the Norwegian leadership of the Global Action Network arrange this webinar, showcasing Nordic cooperation related to sustainable food systems - from healthy waters to healthy people- sharing experiences and lessons learned.
