



By 2030 'Ambitious climate action has set the world on track to achieve the goals of the Paris Agreement and restore ocean health'



Potential of ready-to-implement options to closing the gap in 2050



Key message : Food from the ocean is lagging behind

- Some sectors have progressed, but <u>not</u> the shift toward <u>low-carbon sustainable</u> food from the ocean (e.g., fish protein).
- To make <u>things more complicated</u>, human populations continue to increase along with the demand for protein without an increase in sustainable low carbon options from the ocean
- More must be done to raise awareness, rebuild fisheries, send clear policy signals, and invest in the enabling environments needed to take advantage of this opportunity.
