















**Energy in the Post-2015 Development Agenda** 

The UN Development Group is leading efforts to catalyse a «global conversation» on a new development agenda post-2015 through a series of more than one hundred national consultations and eleven global thematic consultations. One of the 11 major global thematic consultations is on energy. Energy is an important element of global efforts to induce a paradigm shift towards poverty eradication, green economies and ultimately sustainable development.

The global consultation on energy is ongoing and co-hosted by Norway, Mexico and Tanzania. A high level meeting will take place in Oslo on the 9 April to take stock of the inputs that has been submitted from around the world. In advance of the meeting, the UNorganisations in Norway, with support from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Norad, invite the Norwegian society to give their inputs to the discussion on the 12 March.
