

International Deliberative Advisory Board

Nasjonalt Folkepanel om bærekraftig forbruk av varer

The Norwegian Citizen's Assembly on Sustainable Consumption aims to be supported and advised by international experts in deliberative democracy and assembly design, to ensure the integrity and legitimacy of the process, as well as the possible impact.

The experts are asked to join a *International Deliberative Advisory Board* for the process, and invited to at least three digital meetings in the project period, starting June 2024 and ending in February 2025.

The experts will be asked to give input on elements such as design, mandate and remit, and whether these abide by the OECD standard - based on their practical as well as research experience and insights.

This input will mainly be given through digital advisory board meetings (estimated 2 hrs per meeting), but also with the possibility of being asked to participate in meetings with the commissioning body (the Norwegian Ministry for Digitalization and Public Governance).

The board will also be tasked with writing a short statement as the process is concluded. The members may write this together, or opt for a minority statement.
