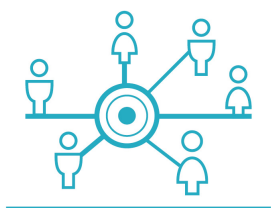

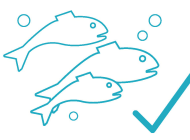
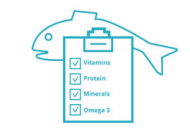
Call for Submissions:

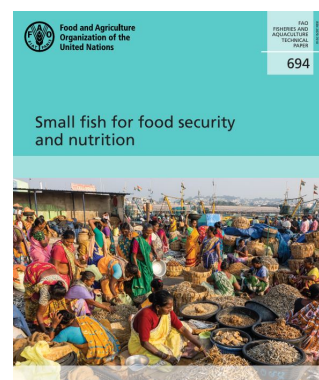
