

### **Integrated Multi-Trophic Aquaculture Makes Work More Rewarding for Coastal Fish Farmers of Bangladesh**

The decline in fish stocks due to overfishing has severely affected the livelihoods of fishing communities in coastal Bangladesh. Testing and refining Integrated Multi-Trophic Aquaculture (IMTA) along the coast is generating new streams of income and nutrition, while cleaning water quality and helping capture carbon.
