

Impacts on safety and dietary value



- Increase consumers confidence in eating seafood
- Provide transparent, useful and user-friendly information
- Promote the sustainable utilization of marine resources
- Provide healthy, nutritious, safe, tailor-made, sustainable and affordable seafood products for vulnerable consumers groups
- Strength seafood security
- Increase employment in sustainable seafood production and processing



Barriers and policy changes required



- Regulations for the utilization of solutions to reduce contaminant levels
- Lack of a nutritional quality certification scheme in Europe for seafood linked to a trustful traceability and quality labeling
- Revision of maximum levels of nutrients (e.g. Se) allowed to fortify farmed fish in feed formulations
- Lack of compulsory strategies to reduce the levels of salt/sodium used in the seafood industry
- Improvement of management tools for harvesting bivalves in production areas (buffer zones)
